Parent and Spectator Code of Conduct

Montgomery Flag Football has implemented the following Parent, and Spectator Code of Conduct. Any parent who violates the Code of Conduct may be asked to immediately leave the field if a resolution cannot be made.

Parent's Code of Conduct (or Legal Guardian):

- I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every practice and game or other event hosted by Montgomery Flag Football.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language or gestures.
- I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of athletes.
- I will ask that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect at all times regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- I will respect the officials and coaches for their authority during games and practices.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the registered coaches for the team or specifically asked by one of the Team's coaches for assistance.
